It will be performed at APT's outdoor amphitheater.

The tickets are \$56 each, and the play starts at 8:00. It is about 21 miles between Blue Mound Park and APT, and it takes about half an hour to get there. It is best to arrive 30 minutes early to park and walk up the hill, which probably takes under 10 minutes. (There is a shuttle bus for those who don't want to hike it.)
